INTRODUCTION

Life is a journey. God loves you and wants you to succeed on that journey. Success in life for every person, including you, will be determined by whether or not they fulfilled God's wonderful purpose for their life. Depending on the path you choose, you can end up in His Eternal Kingdom with His abundant blessings forever, or live the nightmare that never ends. In order to choose the bright path so you can find and fulfill God's purpose you must *grow to know God* more every day. That is what this learning guide is designed to help you do.

Each lesson has three parts: {1} Scripture meditations, {2} Basic Questions, and {3} Scripture memory. The scripture meditations will help you *grow to know the truth of God's Word*. The basic questions will help you live the truth. The scripture memory will help you hide the truth in your heart.

This learning guide will help you *grow to know* the root of all your problems, who your enemy is and how to defeat him, and the solution to your problems. You will also *grow to know God* and how to fulfill His purpose for your life.

Begin each lesson with prayer. Write the answers in your own words. Ask God to help you live the truth that was revealed to you. May God bless you as you *grow to know Him*.

NOTE: It is best to use the King James or New King James Bible as you go through this booklet.

LESSON 1

THE PROBLEM (*SIN*)

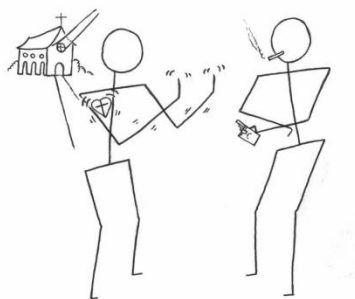

"Father God, thank you for the love you showed in Jesus. I need you. I turn from satan and the things of this world. I open my heart and repent of my sins. Jesus, I believe you died for my sins and rose again. Come into my heart and save my soul. Take control of my life, and be my Lord and Savior. Fill me with your Holy Spirit that I might live for you. Thank you for hearing my prayer, in Jesus' name, I pray. Amen"

3. Have you yielded yourself, your relationships, your goals & ambitions, and your possessions to the Lordship of Jesus? Yes __ no __ If no, pray right now and yield everything you have to God. Ask Him to give you wisdom to use it for His service.
4. Have you asked God to fill you with His Holy Spirit so you can live daily in obedience to God's word? Yes __ no __ If no, pray right now asking God to fill you with His Holy Spirit and give you an obedient heart.
5. Have you obeyed Jesus by being water baptized? Yes __ no __ If no, decide right now that you will be water baptized as soon as possible.

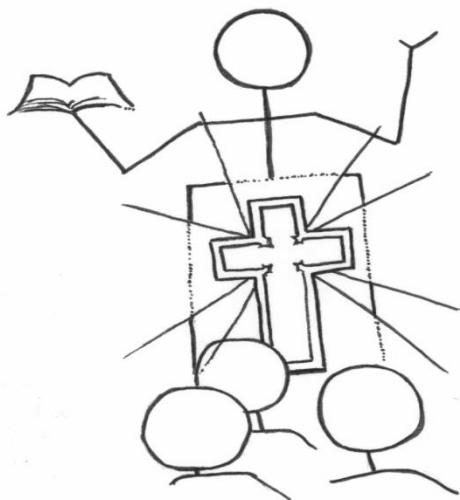

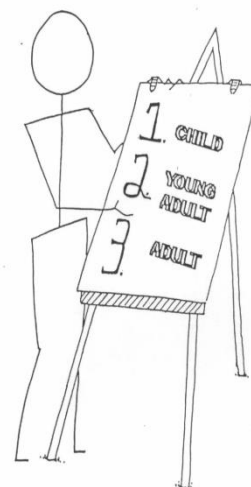
4. What things does God need to remove from your life in order for you to grow spiritually?

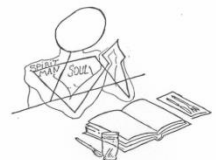

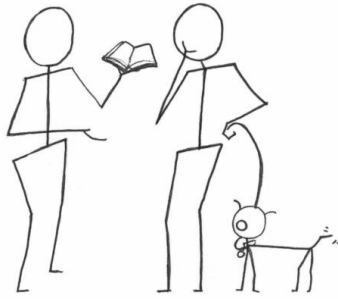
