The Church in Ramechap is growing. Twelve people took water baptism and still others are waiting. A woman of 68 walked 5 hours to get baptized. Many of them want BASIC Bible Training. An elderly man of 65 accepted Jesus. He was the village's favorite witch doctor and the whole village is in awe now. In the beginning the way the seed was sown



in that place was very difficult. All the villagers beat the first believer and cast him out of the village. Even today anybody who fellowships with Christians there is separated from the community of Hindus and Lamas. This is a very hostile place. So please pray for the disciples in Ramechap.

We receive requests from churches to come and help them train their people. This is only possible if we work together. Because of the finances we're trying to decide whether we should have a BASIC Bible School in
