## Pastors Meeting



I am continuing to do ministry despite many problems and challenges. I swallow my tears and bring a smile to my face and encourage my Pastors and Leaders in ministry. Some time it is very difficult. I believe that He who has called me is faithful. It was good to meet with our Pastors and Evangelists. Together with the Pastors we made plans to preach the gospel, we renewed our faith in God, we prayed for each other, and we talked about our problems and how to help each other. As the Bible says with many advisers there is success. I will share what Pastors say about their needs after this report in a separate email. It was good to have around 20 Pastors come for the meeting.

Christian Resource International sent us boxes of books in August. Every year new converts are joining the fellowship of the saints and a number of new Churches are born all around Nepal. The little resources produced by Nepalese are not sufficient. We want God's resources for God's purposes. People wait for a long time for a single Bible in their village, and Bible College students come to ask us for Bibles. There is not a bigger blessing then to put a Bible in their hand. How precious are those people who have donated their books and The Word of God to us. We would like to say a big thank you to CRI for making it possible for us to read the precious writings of famous Christian writers. Reading gets us inspired.



50 Nepali Bibles were purchased in September and were given to very needy people in Llam. The Bible Society publishes sufficient Bibles but they are hard to get into villages in the mountains. Hand carrying is the only medium to bring Bibles to them. One Pastor said 'every day and night I read the Bible and keep it near my pillow.' People travel 12 hours to get a single Bible, we bring Bibles to their houses because there are no shops in the villages where they can get Bibles. Thank you for helping us to purchase The Word of God.

98 people out of 100 are non-believers in Nepal. We started a Christian Football team which connects with local youths and gives them Bibles and tracts. Most of them are surprised when they hear that this is a Christian team.



People from all over Nepal call to know more about the Church Boys Team. [www.churchboysunited.org](http://www.churchboysunited.org). The Church Boys foundation raises the voice of Christians in Nepal. Nepal still treats Christians as second class citizens and they are separated from privileges. We make Jesus' name heard through football.

Church Boys participated in the Jahada Challenge Cup, came in second and received a cash prize of 500 US dollar. A good thing is when Church Boys goes to play the games outside Kathmandu; the team carries Bibles and thousands


of tracts to distribute on the way and to the people. Many new people have shown interest in Jesus, and the backslidden have also reaffirmed their faith in God. People want to know more about Jesus. I will forward some emails and letters of interest they have told me later on.

During my village visits I visited many small house Churches that our former Bible School students have started.

Groups of like 7, 10, 12, sometimes 5 people are gathered every night in some houses. Some are new people and some new disciples. They are learning to forsake drinking, smoking, lying, stealing, fighting, and adultery etc etc. What society was unable to do, Jesus is doing in their life. They sing hymns, worship, read portions of scripture and pray for each other. They even pray for you. Is not this a good thing? Purna Kumar Rai, Binod Dhimal, Paul Rai, Prema Rai, Pratap Praja, Pratap Tamang, Petrus Mukhia are some of the people who are doing a very good ministry now days. They are worthy of our prayers. Through them many people are turning to Jesus. I am so glad that places like Domukha, Kerkha, Dasami, Urlabari, Gaighat, Basamadi, have many new members added to their group. Not only me, but my leaders and Pastors as well are burning with desire for ministry.



Prayers- I have some prayer requests. You know that my computer crashed. My desktop computer was almost four yearsold anyway. Instead of repairing and repairing an old computer, I am praying for a new Laptop now. I hope it will be a Toshiba or Sony. Please tell me which one is good since I don't know them. It needs to have a long battery life, strong, quick processing and be able to resist water. Is there such a computer in the world? Without a computer, I feel it is very difficult for me to communicate and work.



Another prayer request to remember is for the Bible School in Llam. There is a change in dates but it will happen. Christ's Disciple asked us to organize a short term school in their place and we receive this type of request from everywhere. People ask for evangelistic teams, outreach teams, sports teams, film teams and others. I would like to ask you to send a messenger to Nepal. Nepal truly is very hungry for The Word of God. I want to see Nepal turn to God. This is not impossible. This is possible.

Please pray for our Annual conference and Students reunion program December 24-27 in Kathmandu. We would like to give bus fare to the students and at least one way fare to the leaders. We also need funds for food and

accommodations. We need 3000 dollars for fare, food, accommodations, and for some gifts for the Pastors.

One very important prayer request is please pray for a new house for us. We want to shift from here to a bigger place so that we can welcome everybody that comes to visit us. We also need some extra room for guests. A two story house can be rented for 250 dollars and up. This is another challenge for me. We need some partners who can help us financially so that we can continue to do evangelism work and equip others for ministry.

I want to thank you from the bottom of my heart for your emails, encouragement, prayers and financial support. Without your support we would not have come this far. I know what it is to be in need, and I know what it is to have plenty. I have learned the secret of being content in any and every situation, whether well fed or hungry, whether living in plenty or in want. Philippians 4:12.

There is lots of news I could share, but this is the general news. Thank you for your precious prayers. Please continue to pray for my Laptop, Bible School in Llam, Annual Conference and Reunion Program, and for a new house for us. I nearly forgot to ask your prayers for the orphanage land. We have given 3000 dollars and we still need to give 7000 dollars to the land owner. Please pray that God will supply every need in the ministry. I am sorry this letter is very long.
