<u>Now is the time for Nepal.</u> As Bro. Reuben our contact there wrote, "God is doing something in Nepal of which we are privileged to be a part of. Now the door is wide open for us to spread the gospel. Let us not just sit and watch, let us stand up and go to the field to gather the harvest, for harvest truly is ripe but the laborers are few. Please involve yourself like never before and let us spread the gospel together. Let us bring thousands of souls to the kingdom of God." One of the things we did was to walk with some of the students around parliament and the king's palace praying for the country. The day we left Nepal, the newly elected parliament declared a republic, and kicked out the king who had been resistant to the Gospel. Some of the new leaders have told the Christians they have nothing to fear from the new government. Pray that this is so.

Our plan is to return in <u>May 2009</u> and lead a four week school on evangelism, discipleship and church planting. The strategy is to have each church send one or two people with the gift of teaching to be equipped to return to their fellowship and lead them as they seek to spread God's Kingdom in Nepal. It is urgent that we do this while the door is open.
